## **Joint Statement Regarding Response Plan to COVID19**

Dear Parents and Guardians,

This afternoon there was a joint meeting including the Monmouth County Regional Health Commission(MCHRC), personnel from Riverview Medical Center, school personnel from Red Bank Regional, Little Silver, Shrewsbury, Red Bank Borough, and Red Bank Charter as well as town officials, police, and a legislative representative. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the newly discovered “presumptive positive” case of COVID-19 at RBR and the proactive plans for our communities moving forward.

After consultation with the Monmouth County Regional Health Commission, “there is no recommendation to close any of the PK-8 sending school districts at this time.” We will remain open until further notice.

The Monmouth County Regional Health Commission will lead a proactive effort to identify “close contacts” of the “presumed positive” RBR student. We are working in conjunction with the local school districts, the MCRHC, and local hospitals who are working directly with local physicians. We expect to have mitigation discussions on a daily basis.

Limiting the impact of COVID-19 will require a shared response from everyone. We will continue to provide updates and information. Families should continue to consult these resources for information and advice.

### **Declaración conjunta relativa al Plan de Respuesta a COVID19**

Queridos Padres/tutores,

Esta tarde hubo una reunión conjunta que incluyó a la Comisión de Salud Regional del Condado de Monmouth (MCHRC), personal del Centro Médico Riverview, personal escolar de Red Bank Regional, Little Silver, Shrewsbury, Red Bank Borough y Red Bank Charter, así como funcionarios de la ciudad, policía y un representante legislativo. El propósito de la reunión fue para discutir el caso recientemente que se descubrió de "presunto positivo" de COVID-19 en RBR y los planes proactivos para que nuestras comunidades avancen.

Después de consultar con la Comisión Regional de Salud del Condado de Monmouth, "no hay recomendación de cerrar ninguno de los distritos escolares que envían PK-8 en este momento". Permaneceremos abiertos hasta nuevo aviso.

La Comisión Regional de Salud del Condado de Monmouth liderará un esfuerzo proactivo para identificar "contactos cercanos" del estudiante "presumiblemente positivo" de RBR. Estamos trabajando en conjunto con los distritos escolares locales, el MCRHC y los hospitales locales que trabajan directamente con los médicos locales. Esperamos tener discusiones de mitigación diariamente.

Limitar el impacto de COVID-19 requerirá una respuesta compartida de todos. Continuaremos proporcionando actualizaciones e información. Las familias deben continuar consultando estos recursos para obtener información y asesoramiento.
